Elementary Behavior Probation

A student will be accepted and/or placed on probation when the principal feels that the behavior pattern and/or past record indicate that the conduct of the student is questionable or their acceptance causes concern among the administration. During this time some privileges may be denied, and the student will be observed carefully to see if they are making any effort to improve their attitude and actions. At the end of any probationary period, the administration reserves the right to determine whether or not the student will be allowed to continue at Berean Baptist Academy.

- The student must obey every authority on campus.
- The student must follow the rules of his classroom.
- The student must exemplify immediate obedience.
- The student must strictly adhere to the disciplinary policy and code of conduct of BBA.
- The student must not accumulate more than three memos for disobedience or disrespect during the nine week probation period.
- A member of the administration will be in contact with the parents once every three weeks to inform them of the child's progress.
- An evaluation will be made at the end of every three-week period. If the teachers and administration feel that the student is not showing signs of spiritual growth and a desire to excel, the student would be dismissed or asked to withdraw from BBA.
- An evaluation will be made at the end of the probation period. At this time the student would be removed from the disciplinary probation if the administration and faculty are in complete harmony that the student's progress and improvement are sufficient; or if the student has not shown improvement during the probation period, then they would be dismissed or asked to withdraw from BBA.
